ARE you reading one of the 4000 books in your Library? 5396 books were circulated in 1929. Of these, 1351 were books given to children.

The Librarian can be found at the Library on Tuesday and Friday afternoons and Monday and Saturday evenings. She will help you with reference questions that have been given you in school and she will gladly help you to select the book that you wish to read.

Does everyone in your neighborhood know that the Library privileges are for every person living in Twinsburg Township?

During the year just passed, the Reading Room has been much improved by the hanging of pretty net curtains at the windows and by the needed addition of more book shelves and a magazine rack to hold both Adult and Juvenile magazines. Each year since your taxes have helped to support your Library, some improvements have been made in equipment and general appearances.

More books were withdrawn in 1929 than in 1928. Books are not discarded until too worn out for further use. It is the intention of your Library Board to increase steadily the collection of books for the boys and girls, both in books for school use and for home pleasure. A boy or girl with a pleasant story to read is both happy and contented to be at home.

Some of the worth-while and interesting books that have been placed upon the shelves during the past winter are listed. Should you desire any of these books, they may be reserved for you at any time that you wish to send in your request.
