Township?


During the year just passed, the Reading Room has been much improved by the hanging of pretty net curtains at the windows and by the needed addition of more book shelves and a magazine rack to hold both Adult and Juvenile magazines. Each year since your taxes have helped to support your Library, some improvements have been made in equipment and general appearances.

More books were withdrawn in 1929 than in 1928. Books are not discarded until too worn out for further use.
