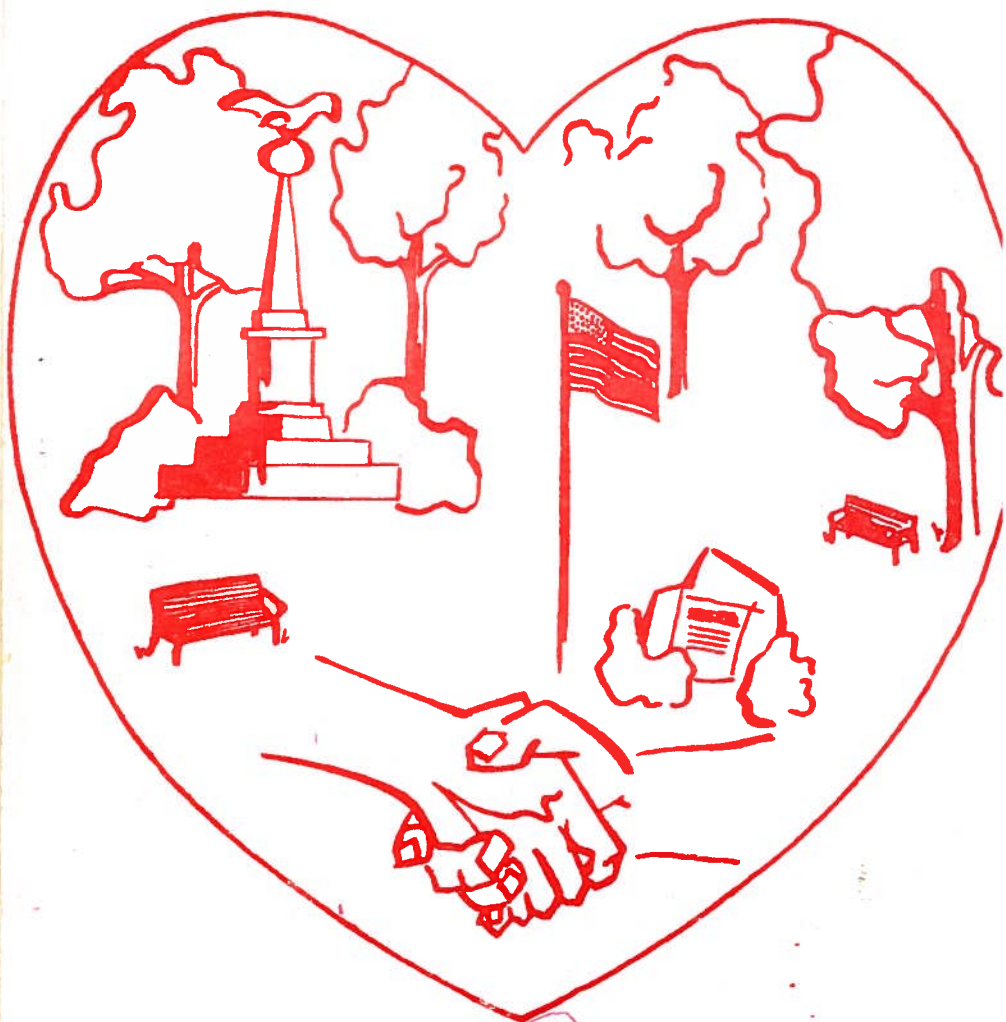

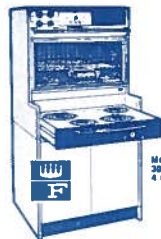

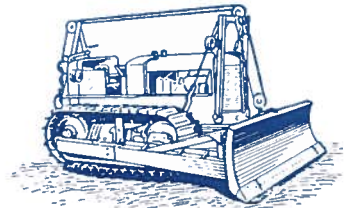

### Twinsburg Public Library

Twinsburg's first library was formed in 1910 as the Samuel Bissell Memorial Library. For fifty-one years, it occupied the same home on the north side of the Village Square. It was forced to move to temporary quarters in 1961 when the old building was razed to provide space for a service station.

Built at a cost of \$165,000 for land and building, the new School District Library stands as testimony to the untiring efforts and constant progress of our community and a free people. Its cherry atmosphere and bright interior, complimented by a capable and hospitable staff reach out as a beacon light to welcome the learner and the learned.

The air-conditioned atmosphere, comfortable study and reading areas combined with the expanded reference section and increased volumes of fiction and non-fiction books provide one of the finest community libraries in the area. A two-fold increase in circulation since the doors were opened on November 19, 1962 is an indication of the acceptance and approval of the new facilities.

From the treasures within, it is sincerely hoped that all ages will learn of the past, accumulate knowledge of the present, and prepare for the future.

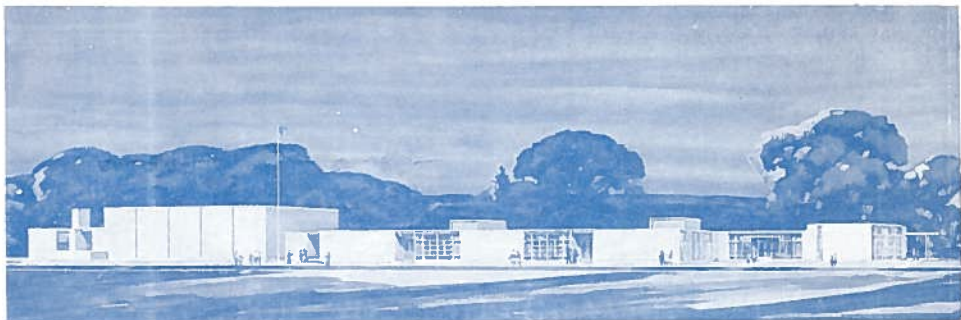

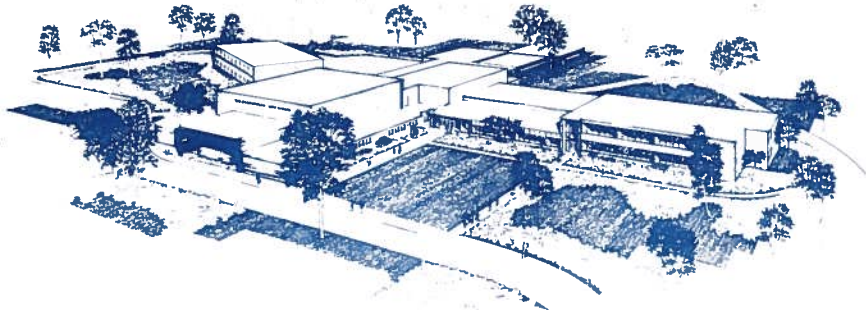

Attention of visitors to the 1963 Home Day is invited to the newest additions to the rapidly expanding Twinsburg School System. Site work is in progress for a fine new elementary school building which will be located on the north side of Glenwood Drive. Occupancy is scheduled for September 1964. The new building will house 618 elementary pupils, with special facilities being provided for a team approach to instruction, library, speech therapy, reading, arts and crafts, music and health and physical education. This school represents an investment by the residents of Twinsburg of \$750,000, including a twenty-one acre site fully developed.

Addition No. 3 to the R. B. Chamberlin High School has been completed this spring at a cost of \$240,000. This addition has greatly expanded the industrial arts shops to provide a broad vocation training program including printing, photography, electronics, and the traditional work in drawing, metals and machine shop and woodworking skills. Also as a part of this addition is a new teaching station for health and physical education, and doubled locker and shower areas for both boys and girls.



### **R.B. Chamberlin High School**

Completed since the 1960 Home Day is the fine new junior high school wing, which has added fourteen classrooms, library and audio visual rooms, with special laboratories for fine arts, science and foreign language. This addition represents an investment of \$489,000 in the future of Twinsburg. Enrollment at the high school will be 800 this fall.

The Wilcox Elementary School on Darrow Road has been serving the primary aged children for the past three years. The balance of the district's 1900 pupils are housed in the original Twinsburg School. The community has reason for pride in its interest and support of a sound education program.

## History Of Twinsburg

Nestled in the valley formed by Tinker's Creek is the picturesque village of Twinsburg, Ohio, which in this year of 1963 is a beehive of activity.

The beauty of the village is accentuated by the hills which surround it on all sides. Not to be overlooked are glimpses of green trees, natural rock ledges and the lovely white steeple of the First Congregational Church. Three busy highways, State Routes 91, 14, and 82, junction in the center of the village and the great Ohio Turnpike is just five miles away.

A very different picture of the area presented itself to Ethan Alling, who at 16 years of age, left Milford, Connecticut, and came to the township April 24, 1817. The forests were unbroken and the only road was a little road that wound in and out among the trees. There were wild animals of all sorts -- deer, bear, wolves, and rattlesnakes. Life was hazardous, which perhaps accounts for the township's being the last one settled in what is now Summit County. Water courses and old Indian trails determined most of the early settlements, and the nearest waterway of any consequence was west of Alling's settlement, while the old trails were farther north or south.

### NAMED FOR TWINS

The township took its name from Amos and Aaron Wilcox, who were twins born in Killingsworth, on the 11th of May, 1771. In early life they so resembled each other that none but their most intimate friends could distinguish between them. They married sisters who were twins, had the same number of children, held all of their property in common, looked alike, thought alike, wrote alike, were taken sick on the same day with the same disease, died on the same day, and were buried in the same grave.

The township, at their request, was named Twinsburg in 1819, and for the honor of giving it a name, they gave six acres of land at the center for a public square, and \$20 to improve it.

Twinsburg today is dynamics in a rural setting. The national tendency toward growth, expansion, and progress is amply exhibited here -- but in a distinctive way. Twinsburg is absorbing both industrial and residential growth into itself.

### WHAT DOES THE VILLAGE AND THE TOWNSHIP, ITSELF, LOOK LIKE?

#### HOUSING:

As you enter Twinsburg, from any direction, you can not help but see and observe great strides that have been made in the growth and improvements in the Village, since incorporation. Should you enter from the north on either State Route 14 or State Route 91, you



will see an additional housing development to the west on Route 14 and on State Route 91, just south of Glenwood Drive a modern apartment development.

#### SANITATION:

In anticipation of the sanitation problems, that would arise from the developments, mentioned above, the administration of 1957 authorized and constructed a modern Sewage Treatment Plant, which is located across from the R.B. Chamberlin High School on Ravenna Road.

This plant is of such design, that it can be readily expanded to handle future growth. Some of this expansion has taken place, since the last home coming with the construction of the East Interceptor and the Cannon Road Sewer Project.

#### WATER:

As a result of all this development, the underground water sources of Twinsburg, were unable to furnish the Village's demands, therefore, the administration started negotiations with the City of Cleveland, to bring water to the community. The extension of new mains, with fire hydrants, has resulted in a reduced fire insurance rate for most of the citizens of the Village of Twinsburg.

#### IMPROVEMENTS:

Twinsburg has continued to grow in an orderly manner since the day of incorporation and here are some of the recent major improvements:

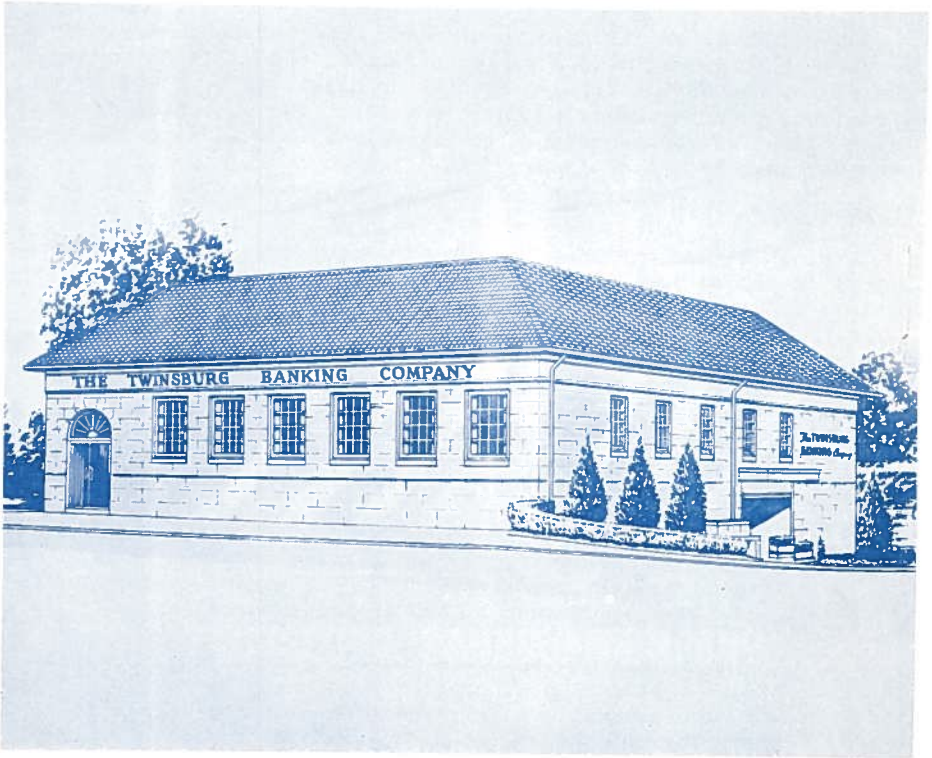
1. Church Street has been widened and paved, with valley curbs, which has provided additional parking for the downtown area.
2. The Village Council authorized and purchased the Municipal Parking lot to the rear of the Village Hall, which serves patrons conducting business with the Village administration.
3. Council authorized street lighting of the downtown and suburban areas, with new lights. The downtown area being lighted with 15,000 incandescent lights and tapering off to 2,500 incandescent lights in the suburban area.
4. In the summer of 1961, the Council authorized and established a recreational program, which has been received by all with enthusiasm. In connection with the recreation program, Council authorized and purchased the Youth Center, which is now known as the Community Center and is available to civic groups of the Village.

Because of the farsightedness of the past and present administration, the Village government has entered into a contract with Tri-County Planning Commission to study our land use needs and present a Master Plan for the Village and Township, which is just another step forward in our planning for future growth.

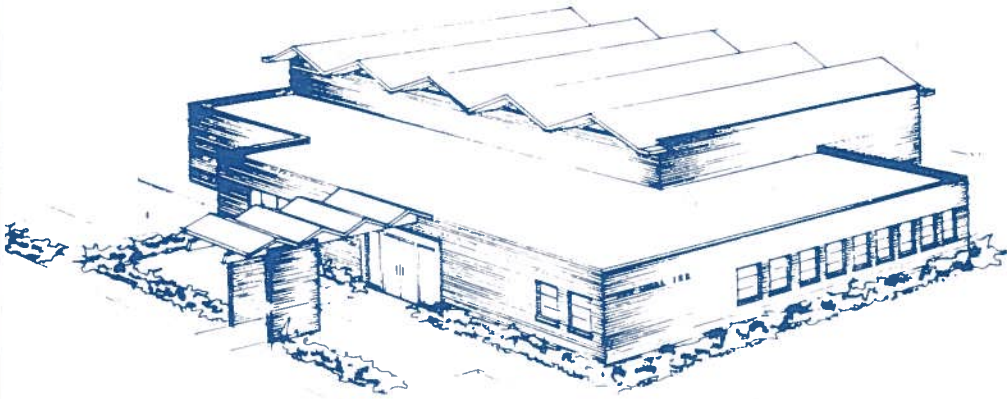

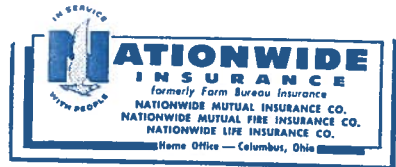

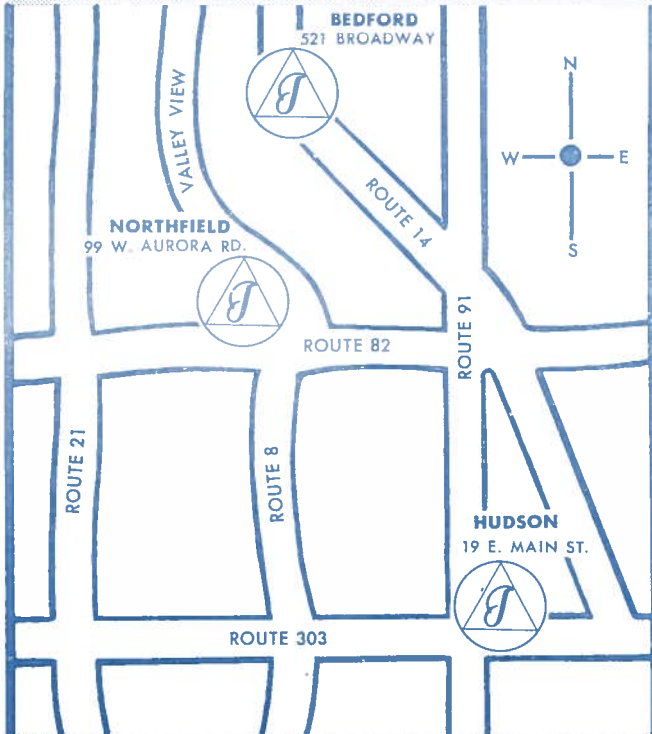
