I wil write you a few lines to let you know that i am stile in the land of of the livering, and of my where abouts we are now encamped in the woods on the banks of the Ten rever in a place where the the bushes to a place ropere the bushes are so thick a man could searcely get through horseback I have been to to work this forenoon do help ent a road through so that we can find our way out not being used to chopping it makes my hund tremble so that i make slow work writing my paper to corried in my old exnapsach and that apassed for a chair makes it of rather poor quality we brather to a hard march in comming here there was two days of the hardes tramping that i have had since i came into the service salurdy and Sundy was the wrorst for me we had searcely any thing to eat a few brackers fridy morning was at that we had til somety night we were up palurdy morning before four there being some that come up with the reg that had not received their pay it was decided

That our reg should go rear gard of the Divisions trains a train that is said to be eight miles long i think not quite so long it was nearly len before the last waggon was on in the road but it was slow getting along the teams had to be watered or the waggon locked going down th hil so that it kept those in the rear standing stite pi most of the Time it march a little ways then Tr standwait so that by dark we were little melined to be lired hungry also but there was at no rest for us it go at night did get into bamp til revale had sounded sundy morn for the men to get readely for the days march 1 being tired our Kernel got permission to rest of a while we were soon streeted out on the groung A asleep but being in a cleared field the sun begun to shine so hot that one and another 09 would crawl out from under his blanket finally concluded that we pad rather be on the march st on we went we lost none from our reg f by sun strokes although droped to in the ranks our boys slood the march th firstrate out of the signal that came from I there is socteen of us all in good spirits enjoying our selso betwee can

on sundy when we sloped to view there was not over half of the reg withe rank being sealered along the road for several miles in the rear a great many a long here have enlisted in the trebel try where we stoped there was a planter that was at the battle at fitsburgh landing was taken prisoner by our troops died soon after this Plan had sent over a hundred States to work on the fortifications at bornth none of this had ever come back we have been some what troubed for water on this march hafte go til we find water that that we muse for booking we get out Army when fighting the Indians i believe it is a rock on this side extending straight up or nearly between it or hundred ft one road down the other places Many go lown on slaus and tadders since we came into At it has been a rien gerlie country nearly al planted to born fields stlending as far us we can see the olaves rad to work by and might to flast it one place where a slave woman was plywing out our one our my steys wen then more bor than yusual a great deal more

have you planted any botton, only one smale piece how much a little over a hundred H it is mostly corn here to stop for it is getting dark and have got to go again on the march to morrow morning of prownolping where we are are going Shave received one Letter from beinge I have three Leters directed to him his furlow is up other is the first chave That is whave shave to send then to late now had no chance to write to him, we have received two months pay i wil risk five in this Setter I shal shurely loose it here this I don't know as you can read this you wil see by looking tover that it was was written in a great Thurang if you can make it out and no one else reads it it is all right to put in Coffee we seldon get any along the road the eattle are all so wild and fear of being griested So here goes Sown

Telorrene June 2 disters Mary & have not received any letters from you yet there are reports heare that our letters are stopped and all the papers destroyed we think there must be something, in the wind either good or bad we are stile at Enforcement gardend the Town but are going to leave at three to morrow morning some say we are going to Chalanoga we don't know but has been intimated as though we would have a long march

we are haveing very warm weather here the logs are all kicking about as usual they are all able to march I have sent fifteen Dollars ten in one five in the other letter wil send fifteer Five in this I did not expect to write I wanted to send the rest of the money Sperman

Dister & received your letter yesterdy dated July to the Nois n No to I have not received I started one yesterdy but with write a few times to send to morrow Jan I woner received a letter with The the one I got was all the mail there was for our Company one week mail it has now been nearly two weeks since we have heard anything from Twinsburgh yours came Through in severiday most generally takes two three and four was I wrote about not being very wel I feel as wel to day as ever I did but am not quite as strong as i yuseto was but are garning fast every day the De told me that i had overdone on the march weeded rest and advised me to get wild Chery Dog wood root back and put in a point of whisky the Whisk could not be got so i have made ted of the barte
